
Sub: Rationalization of Health Benefit Package under AB PM-JAY- reg:

Rationalization of Health Benefit Packages (HBP) under AB PM-PAY is a dynamic process given the continuous request for addition/ removal/ change of packages/ procedures/ rates from States and various stakeholders. A major exercise to rationalize the HBP was done when HBP2.0 was rolled out nationally. However, despite all precautions and intent, it is observed that the revised Health Benefit Packages 2.0 still required improvement in case of some of the specialties. With the development and roll out of Standard Treatment Guidelines by NHA for these packages, modifications were requested medical cell experts as well. As an intermediate revision, HBP 2.1 and HBP 2.2 were introduced. NHA now proposes to come up with a new Health Benefit Packages (HBP 2022) which would be more comprehensive and in line with accepted national and international standards.

2. In view of this, NHA would like to seek feedback from State Health Agencies (SHAs) on the specialty wise master list of packages (HBP2.2). SHAs may after taking inputs from their respective Stakeholders share their inputs with NHA on addition/ deletion / change in procedure name, package name, price, stratification, implant price and specifications, mandatory documents, etc. The inputs once received from SHAs will be collated and sent to NHA medical expert committees for review and further consideration. As this is a time-bound exercise, the SHAs are requested to share their inputs by 30th December 2021 on State specific excel sheet shared in the mail, so as to expedite the process of rationalization. The completed sheet may be sent to exd.hpqa@nha.gov.in.
